

Introduction to Shenzhen

Just 40 years ago, Shenzhen was a small seaside town. Now it's one of China's biggest and most important cities. The city has been named one of China's most livable cities and one of the world's 25 top high-tech development cities.

Shenzhen is located on the southern tip of central Chinese mainland. It is the city in Guangdong Province that is adjacent to Hong Kong on the Chinese mainland border.

During 40 years of rapid development, Shenzhen has become China's biggest electronics manufacturing and export city, a key part of China's "factory of the world". Thanks to a booming trade in electronics, Shenzhen has become China's richest city on the mainland with the highest GDP per capita.

Shenzhen's high-tech industries are developing rapidly. Home to a host of world-famous companies, including Huawei, Tencent, ZTE, and DJI, Shenzhen is also known as China's "Silicon Valley".

1. SMBU

The University boasts pleasant landscape featuring hills and waters, with the Shenxianling and Longkou Reservoirs in the vicinity. There are 21 buildings on campus, including the Main Building, two laboratory buildings, three teaching buildings, a library, a gymnasium, a student activity center, student dormitories, teachers' apartments, etc. As the landmark of the University, the Main Building in

the central square of the campus is modeled on the Main Building of Lomonosov Moscow State University (MSU). There are three cafeterias on campus where you can enjoy a variety of Chinese and international cuisines.



2. Dayun Nature Park

Covering a total area of about 9.45 square kilometers, Dayun Nature Park is a large sports-themed park in Shenzhen. Dayun Nature Park is about a 15-minute walk from the venue.

Dayun Nature Park has four major theme construction: 1, youth theme; 2, sports theme; 3, ecological theme; 4, culture and art theme. In order to express the theme of culture and art, sculpture gardens of commemorative significance are set up in the park, activities such as painting exhibitions and concerts are organized, and even representative works with Chinese characteristics are created with contemporary design techniques, incorporating thoughts on local history and culture.





3. Yangmeikeng Valley

Located in Daya Bay, Yangmeikeng Valley is known as the most beautiful stream valley in Shenzhen. Visitors can experience swimming, biking, diving, barbecue, sailing and yachting here. Yangmeikeng Valley is about 70 minutes 'drive from the venue.
